For example, when you connect your phone to your Mac and authenticate it, a popup arrives and asks you for a code to protect your iPhone. If you haven't synced with iTunes in a while, or if you changed your password after installing iOS 5, you will be prompted to enter a new password. If you see an error message. The instructions below assume you're working from a PC. If you're connecting from an iOS device, check out Get to iCloud Sign-in. If you have a Mac, the process of connecting with Windows Mail is similar, but a little bit different. Check out Get to Mail on iCloud. The Passwords and Accounts system contains the settings to sync your passwords and accounts across macOS and Windows. It also lets you manage email-based Apple IDs. On the MacBook, click Apple () in the menu bar, and then click System Preferences. Click iCloud. You may be prompted for your Apple ID login information to finish the setup. Click your Apple ID. Next to Mail in the list, click Add Mail Account. Enter your email address, and then click Next. Select the account type that you want, and then click Next. Enter the email address you used to verify your Apple ID. Enter the password for your selected account, and then click Next. You may be asked to sign in to your Mail.app account. Click Done. Sign in to iCloud from your desktop, back on your Mac, or from the Mail app in your iOS device. In the Preferences window, you can choose to sync Contacts, Calendars, Reminders, or Notes across macOS and Windows. You can also change the frequency of sync. Click iCloud Options to view any preferences that weren't automatically selected. With the iCloud account set up, you can add your Microsoft accounts to your iCloud account. If you've moved beyond keeping the iCloud account locally, you can now turn iCloud on and off from System Preferences. Click your name in the menu bar to open your Contacts app. With your iCloud account selected, click Sign In. If you haven't added any email accounts to your iCloud account yet, you'll be prompted to add them. For the email accounts that are currently stored with the iCloud account, click the account, and then click Use This Account With Your iCloud Account.
